


# Tribal Sovereignty and Consultation

# Federal Obligations to Native Education

- Between 1778 and 1871, 378 treaties or treaty supplements were made with tribes
  - ▶ 174 contain educational provisions
- The first treaty was with Oneida in 1794 and the last was with Nez Perce in 1868

### **Boarding Schools**

#### 2 types

- Missionary: Meant to convert Native people to Christianity
- **Federal**: Focused on "civilizing" Native children

#### By 1913

- **69** mission schools
- 328 government schools
  - **217** day schools
  - ▶ **76** reservation boarding schools
  - > 35 off-reservation boarding schools

## Tribal Educational Rights

#### Tribes have the right

- to determine who will represent them in all governmental consultations
- to educate their citizens
- to educate non-Native people about their tribe

#### **Common Tribal Educational Values**

- Language
- Culture
- Educational decisions consider:
  - Surrounding environment
  - Other tribes
  - ▶ Plants
  - ▶ Animals

- Mother Earth
- Cosmos
- Ancestors
- ▶ Future generations
- ▶ Spiritual world
